Winston not at university disciplinary hearing

Reports that Florida State star quarterback Jameis Winston was going to attend a university disciplinary hearing today are not true,

according to Tallahassee attorney Tim Jansen.

Jansen, who represented Winston in his sexual battery allegation late last year, said both he and Winston were not notified or requested to attend any hearing today.

Winston, along with teammates Chris Casher and Ronald Darby, and the woman who accused Winston of rape were expected to attend the hearing, Baine P. Kerr, the accuser's attorney, told ESPN.

John Clune, another attorney representing the woman, told Fox Sports News Winston was expected to be present and may be questioned.

Jansen said Winston has been in North Carolina for the ACC baseball tournament with the FSU baseball team since Sunday and isn't expected to come back until this Sunday.
